This carbon footprint baseline considers the impact of self-generated electricity.







### **Emissions Reduction Targets**

Red Lands Roses Plc has achieved 17.12% CO<sub>2</sub>e reduction (in year 2020/2021) and 14% CO<sub>2</sub>e reduction (2021/2022) against a 5% reduction target year on year. This means that the company is on track to achieve a Net zero target on or before year 2042.






- Better/more efficient cold rooms and delivery truck coplers.
  - a. More efficient cold room 90% done by Dec 2023, to be completed by January 2024
  - Delivery trucks has been equipped with more efficient truck coolers one old truck to be replaced in year 2024.
- 3. Efficient spray pumps The company has bought two efficient pulsfog at a cost of 1M each







Increase solar capacity to 60% (From the current 30%) of clean energy by December 2024

- 4. Already built a big water reservoir now in use from January 2023 to increase the capacity of rain water harvest
- 5. We have transitioned to 100% to paper sleeves from June year 2023
- 6. Efficient recycling of Greenhouse plastic paper
- Planted 13,000 trees though "Adopt a forest" initiative from Kenya Association of manufacturers. The company plan to continue with this initiative of planting at least 10,000 trees every year.



Red Lands Roses Plc has a reduction target of 5% year on year. However, based on the current reduction achieved over the last two years, and the initiatives that the company continue to implement,

We project that carbon emissions will decrease to 2,195 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2025.

This is a reduction of 40%

We project that carbon emissions will decrease to 1,464 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2030.

This is a reduction of 60%



### Carbon Reduction Projects

## Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives:

- 1. Replaced 50% of R22 Refrigerants
- 2. Use of organic glue to make boxes rather than pins.
- 3. Re-usable plastic buckets in the cold rooms to replace organic one use boxes.
- 4. Water recycling in the Greenhouses (100% hydroponics)
- 5. Solar Park which generates 23% of clean energy
- 6. Purchasing of more durable Personal protective equipment's which last longer.
- 7. New bigger water reservoir to store storm water for rain water harvesting.
- 8. Introduction of paper sleeves
- 9. Carbon offseting



### Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives:

- 1. Continue upgrading the old cold rooms for better efficiency
- 2. Switch from Diesel powered trucks to electric powered flower delivery
- 3. Continue with the "Adopt a forest" initiative from KAM increase the acreage
- 4. Continue with rain water harvesting
- 5. Registration and assessment of our rose flowers plantation as a carbon sink.
